2. Party tags

This section explains how the party tag dataset was constructed from the semi-structured Wikipedia data.

First, as mentioned in the main text, we scraped all the pages for the parties using a custom web scraper. These pages were saved to disk in HTML format for ease of re-use and reproducibility purposes. The Wikipedia page for a given party changes frequently for active parties, so one has to settle on a particular version at some point in time. We scraped the party data on 13 June 2020, meaning that the pages on that date are the ones used for this study.

After downloading the pages, we parsed the HTML in R using the **rvest** package (Wickham & RStudio, 2019), and extracted the infobox when it was present. For some parties (mostly minor or defunct/historical) no infobox was present, and our database therefore contains no corresponding data for political position or ideology. The figure above shows an example of an infobox for the Sweden Democrats (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Sweden_Democrats), a Swedish nationalist party.

The ideology section of the infobox contains all the political labels or tags that various sources have attached to this party (e.g. Swedish nationalism, economic nationalism), with the sources marked using numbers in brackets, as per the Wikipedia referencing system.

Below that is the party's political position, given in semi-standardized words. In this case, the party has been called 'right-wing' to 'far-right'.

The same data were gathered for all the parties, and the references (numbers in brackets) were removed. Each label was examined manually, and labels were grouped into similar tags for the purpose of coding. The R code below shows the regex codes that were used for this classification.

The assignation of the various tags was done via a two-step approach:

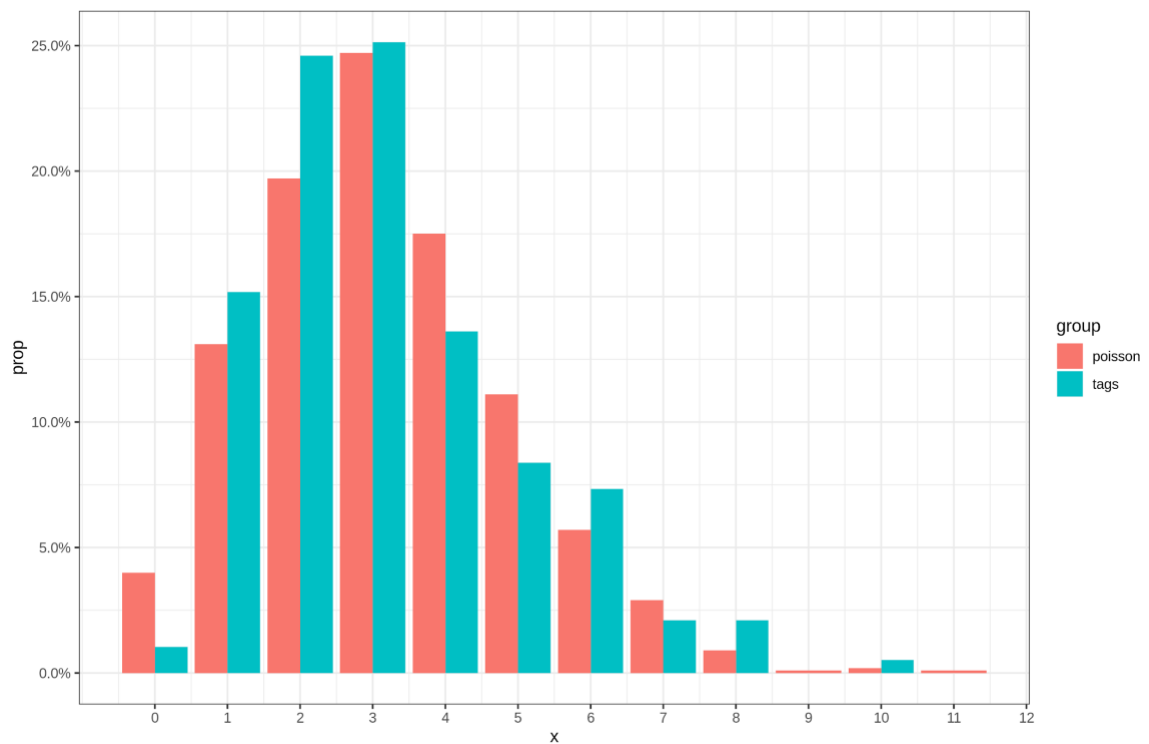
1. For each party, count the number of tags assigned positively to this party.
2. For the parties with few or no assigned tags, browse their labels and look for commonalities with existing tags or other parties' ideology text. Convert at least one of these into a tag - regex pattern.

This process continues until almost all parties have been assigned tags. The table below shows the counts of tags per party.

Two parties did not have text that allowed for a classification into a tag. For instance, the Maori party of New Zealand only had one ideology listed (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/M%C4%81ori_Party), “Māori rights”, which did not appear anywhere else in the database.

Using this approach we ended up with 21 political tags. The mean number of assigned tags per party was 3.2, with a median of 3, and SD of 1.8. The maximum was 10 and minimum 0. We used the **fitdistrplus** (Delignette-Muller et al., 2020) to compute distribution statistics. The data seemed to follow roughly a poisson distribution. The figure below shows the real tag data and simulated poisson data, with the lambda parameter (3.2) estimated from the tag data.



We also counted the number of parties by tag, as shown in the table below:

3. Exclusion rules

This section contains more information about the data exclusion rules.

We used multiple data sources, each of which had some amount of missing data. Since the final multivariate analysis utilised complete cases, this necessarily means that some cases were not used. In addition, since the bivariate analyses utilised pairwise complete data, the sample size for these analyses depended on the amount of overlapping data for the two variables in question. Finally, some parties enjoy very low levels of voter support, meaning that the sampling error for the corresponding relative preference metrics is rather high. While we used weights in order to deal with this, we also excluded the very smallest parties, namely those that got less than 2% of the popular vote. Only two countries in our study have election thresholds at or below the value of 2%: the Netherlands (no threshold, but has 150 seats in parliament, so the de facto threshold is $100/150 = 0.67\%$) and Denmark, which has 2%. Finally, the voting data also contains the remainder values. These correspond to other even smaller or unknown parties, or invalid votes (sources sometimes left out smaller parties, so we could not determine the votes). The remainder values were not used in any analysis but do contribute 10 cases to the voting data.

The table below shows the missing data by variable, as well as the exclusion rule of 2%. 'TRUE' indicates that a particular item was *missing*. Note that for some countries (e.g. Belgium), we were unable to locate any surveys of journalists, so all the parties from these countries have missing data.
